



BITE Job opportunity

We are looking for a suitable candidate to become part of our incredible Team Building with BITE team. This is a unique role, assisting on Team Builds, College/University bookings and enclosure builds across the UK.

At Team Building with BITE we take corporate bookings for groups of between 5-200, as well as building enclosures/enclosure furnishings and enrichment at animal collections and colleges across the UK. Occasionally we need the help of assistant instructors for some bookings, and we have an amazing team of instructors who assist in these situations. There are two potential roles which include, but are not limited to:

Team Builds and College Days

- Helping with the setup events, which could be inside or outside.
- Offering advice and help to participants.
- Monitoring participants with regards to H&S.
- Communicating with animal keepers on the day.
- Setting up the feeders or furniture in animal enclosures.
- Talking to participants about the animals and behaviours.
- Filming and photographing the workshop.
- Helping pack up once the workshop is finished.

Enclosure builds:

- This role is for those that love to be hands on, and so would be suitable for someone with practical skills.
- Full days working on site over several days or weeks in all weather.
- Using hand and power tools, manual handling and digging.

Because we work in many different locations, the ability to travel is essential. The successful candidate will be paid for their time assisting on the builds, and other CV enhancing opportunities may also become available.

Who are we looking for?

- A large part of the Team Build role is dealing with people, so first and foremost good public-facing skills are vital. Knowing when to step in, offer advice and suggestions, as well as talking to the participants in a friendly, upbeat, constructive, positive and professional manner is key.
- Practical skills such as drill and saw use are advantageous for events, but are not critical.
- The ability to be self-motivated, punctual, and show common sense is a must.
- Flexibility, as we never know when bookings which require help might come up, each workshop you assist with may be days or weeks apart. The ability to work around your current job or other commitments is therefore incredibly useful.
- Ability to problem solve and think quickly in a fast moving environment.

What will the interview day entail?

We will be holding a practical day at Lakeview Monkey Sanctuary, in Ascot, for the selected participants. The day will run from 9am to around 3pm on Monday 13th December. We will have practical and theoretical activities. It may be simple, it may be complex, but the idea of the day is to see how you work, and how you communicate and engage with others. We will have a 1-1 with each candidate within that time as well.

This is a casual day, and we will be working outside in woodlands of the sanctuary, so sensible clothing that you do not mind getting dirty is a must.
