Aquaculture Training Opportunity (5 positions available January 15, 2023)

Application details: Deadline is 28th December 2022; Trainees will be chosen January 5th, 2023; Training starts on January 15th 2023.

Duration: 15 January to 12 May, 2023

Description: Five(5) commercial-aquaculture trainee positions will be available beginning 15 January, 2022. Location of internship will be at Flosell Farms, LLC. (Sogokope, Ghana). Training opportunities will be compensated positions that will give students an opportunity to learn skills associated with the operation of a commercial tilapia farm such as fish biology, brood fish management, larval and juvenile fish rearing, fish disease management, water quality management, and culture system operation. Additionally, selected candidates will take part in lectures and seminars conducted via Zoom on specialty topics associated with successful fish farming practices. These seminars will be conducted by WISHH aquaculture consultants who have teaching experience at universities around the world. Trainees will also be **required** to write a summary paper of skills and lessons learned during this learning experience to receive final payment. Certificate of training will be issued.

Compensation: Trainees will be compensated at a rate of \$800 (USD) plus lodging, 2 meals per day, and some local travel for the term of the internship.

Application Requirements: Applicants must be either enrolled and in good academic standing at either University of Ghana-Legon, University of Cape Coast, or Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology (KNUST) and at least a Junior (60% of class work completed) or recently (within 3 years) graduated from University. Applicants must have excellent English language skills and should submit a letter of application detailing experience in aquaculture, reasons for applying for this internship, and career goals. Additionally, a letter of recommendation must be submitted. Candidate applications will be assessed by WISHH and Flosell Farms and interviews completed before final selection. Selected candidates will be required to provide their own transportation to Ghana and meet immigration requirements. Applications will begin 20 December, 2022. ***Women are especially encouraged to apply.***
